

### HOW DOES YOUR CENTER QUALIFY?

- You must be licensed with a federal, state or local licensing authority
- A minimum of 25% of the children enrolled in your center must qualify free or reduced meals (Note: We will help you qualify your families. A family of 4 making \$51,338 or less would qualify toward your 25%).
- · You must be one of the following:
  - A public agency
  - Private non-profit organization (must have a tax-exempt status (501(c)(3))
  - Private for-profit organization meeting the 25% qualification
  - Private for-profit accepting School Readiness benefits for at least 25% of enrollment or 25% of licensed capacity, whichever is less

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## WHO IS CORNERSTONE FAMILY MINISTRIES?

Cornerstone Family Ministries is a 501 (c) (3) Non-profit organization that has been serving the Tampa Bay Area since 1892. # WHAT IS THE CHILD CARE FOOD PROGRAM (CCFP)?

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) established the Child Care Food Program (CCFP), in 1968 in response to the need to provide adequate nutrition to a growing number of children in day care. The goal of the CCFP is to see that well-balanced meals are served and that good eating habits are taught in childcare settings. The CCFP provides supplemental reimbursement for nutritious meals and snacks served to all children in qualifying licensed centers. The CCFP is administered in Florida by the Department of Health, Bureau of Child Care Food Programs. The USDA provides funding for the program.

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THE CCFP FOR YOUR CHILD CARE CENTER?

The CCFP supplements the cost for qualifying Child Care Centers and Child Care Homes for "serving" up to two nutritious meals and one snack to all children (including infants) in their care.



### WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF BEING SPONSORED BY CORNERSTONE?

- Expedited enrollment in the CCFP.
- All children receive nutritious meals.
- Reimbursement for every nutritious meal served, without the liability of a direct contract with the Florida Department of Health.
- Initial training and technical assistance provided to center staff for the program.
- Food and nutrition training to center staff for inservice credit at no cost to the center.
- Approved menus that take the worry out of menu planning.
